On January 30th, 2008, Mike Bickle, Director of the International House of Prayer, Kansas City; Lou Engle, Founder of The Call and Graham Power, Director of the Global Day of Prayer stood on stage in front of 600 missions leaders at Call2All Orlando.

It marked an historic coming together of the prayer and missions movements.

Mike Bickle explains it like this: "Jesus the man who is leading the Great Commission is also Jesus the Great Intercessor – He is one man, and this is one reality in His heart. In God's heart these two movements are one movement, it's in man's eyes they're two.

"The two things will happen simultaneously, the gospel will go to every nation and the prayer movement will go too, preparing the way through fasting and prayer, and then when the gospel goes the people are converted and become worshippers calling out for Jesus' return. So the missions movement will fuel the prayer movement which will release power back on the missions movement. It's all one big reality in God's heart.

### **Fire in the Night**

April 1-June 29, 2009

Due to the 24/7 nature of the International House of Prayer, the hours between midnight-6AM are affectionately called the NightWatch. Fire in the Night (FITN) is the IHOP-KC's internship program, which stands in prayer during those hours. The internship is for young adults between the ages of 18-30. The program consists of two separate three-month tracks. Track I is

an introduction to theological concepts such as the Bride of Christ, End Times, spiritual warfare and forerunner themes. Track II continues with a deeper study in the topics listed as well as times of receiving ministry and impartation through the laying on of hands for each intercessor. There will also be training in prophetic and healing ministry. We are calling young adults to give up a summer, a semester or a season of work to intensively seek the face of Jesus.

### **International 40 Days for Life campaign focuses on prayer, fasting – and healing**

WASHINGTON, DC – More than 130 cities in the United States and Canada – as well as locations in Australia and Northern Ireland, which are participating for the first time – are kicking off a 40-day campaign seeking an end to abortion. 40 Days for Life begins tomorrow and runs through April 5.

40 Days for Life, which coincides with the start of the Christian season of Lent, is an intensive 40-day program of prayer and fasting, community outreach, and constant vigil outside abortion facilities, Planned Parenthood offices and other public locations.

This is the fourth coordinated, simultaneous 40 Days for Life campaign. Thus far, more than 175,000 people in 204 cities have participated. Three abortion facilities have shut their doors following 40 Days for Life events; thirteen employees have left the abortion business, and 1,128 babies have been saved from abortion through the prayerful presence of people peacefully standing outside the clinics.
