The event took place on May 24th 2009 in the grounds of Wiston House, West Sussex, UK.

A gathering of 14,000 British Christians came together for a justice-focused celebration of the UK Church. **TheBigChurchDayOut** is an exciting new one-day event focussed on gathering the church from London and the South of England, celebrating together as a church. A day of music, worship, prayer, fun and just being together and an expression of unity and beauty.

Pete Greig and Carla Harding hosted the day from the main stage introducing world-renowned worship leaders like Michael W. Smith, Israel Houghton and Delirious. Prayer and justice were the cornerstones of the gathering with moments of prayer and stirring messages from leaders interspersing the festivities.

The BigChurchDayOut is run by a team that is headed up by Tim Jupp, one of the founding members of Delirious, in partnership with the Wiston Estate. It is supported by both many local churches and national organizations that together have a heart for serving the church.

Week of Prayer for Parliament and Government

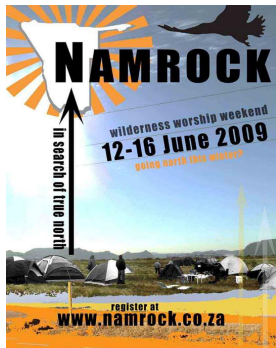
Christians from across the UK will join together to pray in and around Westminster, as part of the Week of Prayer for Parliament and Government 7-12 June 2009.

God's CALL 2 FALL
on my knees in humility
and seek His face in repentance,

The **Call 2 Fall** is setting aside a definite time during worship on July 5th 2009 when you call your people to get on their knees and faces before the Lord in repentant prayer for God to reshape our lives and renew our land.

"Call 2 Fall" on our knees is for every Christ-follower in America. Believers are encouraged to kneel at least 3 to 5 minutes before the Lord wherever they may gather that day.

"Call 2 Fall" in corporate humility before the Lord is set for Sunday July 5, 2009. Why a Call 2 Fall? First, the Scriptures teach it. The key verse is 2 Chronicles 7:14.

Second, history records it. The First Continental Congress called for a day of public humiliation, fasting, and prayer throughout the Colonies on July 20th, 1775 just after war broke out. In addition, colonial America and the early years of our republic experienced what observers have called Great Awakenings, which began with God's people humbling themselves in repentant prayer and led to others becoming followers of Christ. Third, the nation needs it. We are witnessing what happens when a nation turns away from God.

North Korean Christians pray

According to Michelle A Vu, the underground Christian body in North Korea has launched a prayer campaign for evangelisation in the country in response to the government's recent missile testing and threat to attack its southern counterpart, South Korea.

Church leaders in the country say the situation is extremely unstable inside and urge North Korean Christians to become more united during this difficult time, according to Open Doors sources.

"Christians in North Korea are suffering terribly for their faith," said Open Doors USA president and CEO Carl Moeller. "Of the estimated 200,000 in

political prison camps, an estimated 40,000 to 60,000 are Christians... the scrutiny of believers has increased.”

Open Doors ranked North Korea as the No 1 persecutor of Christians for the seventh year in a row in its latest World Watch List.

Dictator Kim Jong-Il is said to be greatly afraid of the expansion of Christianity in North Korea. He reportedly attributes the fall of communism in Eastern Europe to the expansion of Christianity and fears he will be toppled if the religion grows in the country.

Moeller asks churches in the West to support North Korean Christians by keeping them in special prayer.
