A city-wide leadership will be formed to provide a neutral place for all churches to come, worship, and pray together.

Call2All Hong Kong 1-4 June 2009.

About 3,000 ministry leaders from more than 100 countries united in Hong Kong from 1 to 4 June 2009 to strategize for the completion of the Great Commission. The first day began with a solemn assembly of prayer, where God healed historical wounds and brought the various delegates together as one before Christ. Later in the day, delegates were introduced to one of the largest maps in the world ever printed. All 3,000 in attendance were able to walk on the map and pray over 4,000 locations, committing to go wherever God would send them. This massive group of Christian leaders then began to walk back and forth across the map of the world, as well as circling it, declaring the greatness of God over the nations. Together they pledged obedience to God's Great Commission.

The Reformation Prayer Network builds upon the revelation out of Genesis 22:17, "...your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies". This prayer network is strategically built to systematically affect each sector of society. It is focused specifically around the seven gates or mountains of societal influence (**Family, Religion, Government, Business, Media/Communications, Arts/Entertainment, and Education**), which is used on both national and state levels. Currently, they are building the network in all fifty states of the USA for each of the seven mountains as well as building prayer networks among local churches, children, youth, and intercessory worshipers. National coordinators for various people and language groups are being appointed. Each state and special focus prayer

network is free to choose their own projects, areas of emphasis, and prayer initiatives. However, there will be occasions where they will pray together as "One New Voice".

They use different methods to mobilize prayer: A Monthly Prayer Calendar, Prayer Coupons with Information and Prayer Points concerning Various Countries, Open Prayer Days and Facilitate Congregations to Pray for Least Evangelized People Groups.

SAAWE mobilizes the body of Christ towards a multiplication-action focused on the least evangelized people groups.
