### **'Candles and prayers' against the Berlin Wall**

LEIPZIG - East Germany's secret police had plans to crush every single threat to the communist regime "but it didn't reckon on candles and prayers".

The comment by the head of the secret police in Leipzig is fictional and taken from a novel about the 1989 fall of the Berlin Wall. However, given how often it comes up in speeches and historical accounts it might as well be fact.

The revolution "which went off peacefully started in the church," according to Christian Fuehrer, 66, who retired last year after 28 years as pastor of Leipzig's Protestant Nikolai Church.

A leading figure in the "Monday demonstrations" which helped bring down the communist regime, Fuehrer was among the first to open his church to the "peace prayer meetings" which later snowballed into mass rallies.

He first held "peace prayer meetings" in 1982 to protest the arms race. Then only half a dozen turned up. By 1988, he had invited small groups advocating

political reform to hold public discussions at the church, whose first stones were laid in the 12th century.

On September 25, 1989, 7,000 turned up for a "no violence" vigil as the communist regime threatened to clamp down on growing protests.

By October 9, 70,000 converged on the square outside the church for a rally.

The protest triggered a chain reaction, which ended with the opening of the Berlin Wall on November 9 and the subsequent fall of the regime.

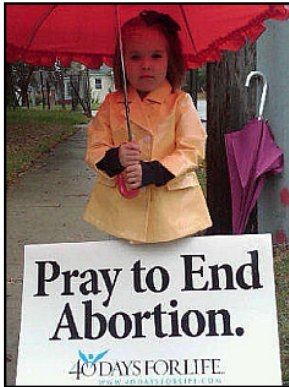
## **The Vision of Praise and Worship Prayer.**

## **40 Days for Life Reaches Milestone: 2,000 Babies Saved from Abortion**

"Through the grace and mercy of God—and the faithful prayers of more than 200,000 volunteers standing vigil outside abortion facilities—an incredible miracle has taken place," said David Bereit, national director of 40 Days for Life. "Starting with the first-ever 40 Days for Life campaign in Bryan/College Station, Texas in 2004, and continuing through the international 40 Days for Life effort that is under way this fall, we now have confirmed reports of at least 2,000 babies whose lives have been saved from the tragedy of abortion," Bereit said.

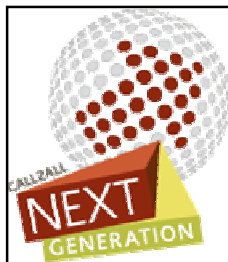
"When people ask me what to say when they're at the vigil," said Bereit, "I often say—just pray and don't worry about it. We have countless stories of women rejecting abortion and leaving the clinics even when not a single word was spoken."

It is often the prayer of children that has this effect.

40 Days for Life is the largest and longest coordinated pro-life mobilization in history. The fall 40 Days for Life campaign, began September 23 and concluded on November 1. The initiative, in 212 cities across 45 American states, five Canadian provinces, and Denmark, consists of 40 days of intense prayer and fasting for an end to abortion, peaceful vigils outside abortion facilities, and grassroots community organizing.

Since 2004, some local 678 campaigns have been conducted in 282 communities, covering all 50 American states, the District of Columbia and American Samoa, as well as Canada, Australia, Northern Ireland and Denmark.
