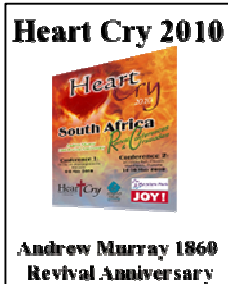
INTERNATIONAL PRAYER CENTRE WINTER OLYMPICS

THE PILGRIMAGE OF TRUST IN ASIA

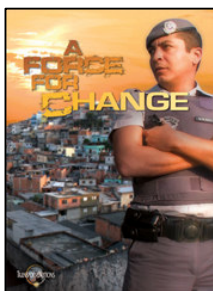


During the meeting in Brussels, Belgium, Brother Alois announced that the next stage of the pilgrimage of trust on earth in Asia will be an international young adult meeting to be held in the Philippines, in the city of Manila, from 3 to 7 February 2010.

This will be the fifth meeting of its kind in Asia, following meetings organized by Taizé in Chennai (Madras), India, in 1985 and 1988, Manila, Philippines in 1991, and Kolkata, India in 2006.

The 40,000 young adults from all over Europe and other continents gathered in Brussels responded with prolonged applause to the invitation to go to the Philippines.

A FORCE FOR CHANGE. This DVD tells the tale of a corrupt Police Force that changed to become a Force for Change. The São Paulo police force was corrupt, brutal, and despised. In 2003, however, several senior officers saw the *Transformations* documentary and major changes began to unfold. Godly strategies emerged leading to dramatic turnarounds in the city's most violent neighbourhoods. Now other police forces across the nation are asking how they can replicate this success.

The São Paulo police force is the largest and best-equipped law enforcement agency in the southern hemisphere. Employing well over 100,000 personnel, the force boasts aerial support operations, mounted cavalry, a counter-terrorism unit, riot-control troops, and an impressive criminal intelligence division. Out of the view of tourists and reporters, elements of this powerful

force have long been playing cosy with underworld drug dealers and racketeers. Other officers, fed up with the justice system's corrupt revolving door, have turned to vigilantism. The protectors of the law became a law unto themselves.

A group of burdened officers asked God to intervene... to transform them into change agents...on the force and within society. The impressive results now have scores of other police departments asking how they, too, can become **A FORCE FOR CHANGE**.

NATIONAL 'ROOT 52' PRAYER CAMPAIGN

According to Adrienne S. Gaines of Charisma News a yearlong prayer campaign is traveling

across the United States to reclaim the nation's Christian roots.

Dubbed Root 52, the 52-week prayer strategy will move from state to state in the order they entered the union, as local intercessors fast and pray for government leaders and for the state to return to its prophetic "covenant roots."

"If we will take our place in repentance, bowing low before God in humility with fervent prayer and fasting, seeking God's face and his heart towards our nation, we believe that united with God and one another, a nation can be shifted," wrote Root 52 organizers Mike and Cindy Jacobs, founders of Generational International and the Reformation Prayer Network.

"In Hebrew, the United States is translated *Artzot Ha-Brit*, which means 'lands of covenant,'" Mike and Cindy Jacobs wrote on the campaign Web site. "If we will covenant together as the body of Christ, we have an opportunity to turn this battle at the gates. ... We believe that as the call goes out and the praying church arises, uniting in heart and purpose, that we will stand strong. As a result, we will see the walls of deception, seduction, lies and rhetoric come down like those of Jericho."

The campaign is part of a year of "humiliation, fasting and prayer" Cindy Jacobs called in December 2009 to "turn the nation back to God."

THE SACRED CHARGE is a seven-fold lifestyle commitment for those who desire to live as forerunners. The forerunner message emphasizes Jesus' second coming, while proclaiming and manifesting the power of Jesus' first coming, as forerunners win the lost, heal the sick, help the poor, and walk in love and holiness. Forerunners imitate the lifestyle of John the Baptist and the New Testament apostles, who rejected the professional robes of religion for a lifestyle of radical obedience to Jesus and walking in the power of the Spirit. This involves embracing a lifestyle that includes much prayer with fasting as they seek to go deep in the Word, while at the same time winning the lost, healing the sick, making disciples, church planting, and operating in the power of the Spirit to meet the needs of people.

As forerunners proclaim the Word and do the works of the kingdom, they glorify Jesus and deliver the oppressed; by the very same activity, they are being preparing to be used even more in the years ahead. For those with a specific call to be a forerunner and to raise up other forerunners, these commitments are the starting point in walking out the forerunner lifestyle practically. The seven commitments are:

- Pray Daily
- Fast Weekly
- Do Justly
- Give Extravagantly
- Live Holy
- Lead Diligently
- Speak Boldly
